Reminders:

Mobility scores have been raised for this season - Level 4 will now need a 34.00AA to move to level 5 - Level 5, 6 & 7 need a 32.00AA to move to the next level . They are in the USA Gymnastic rules and policy for 2017-18 that is available at the National web site - You should all have a copy of

the R&P for reference

XCEL mobility for JO - remember that JO athletes must follow the Entry rules to compete in XCEL divisions

Level 1 & 2 - must enter at Bronze or Silver

Level 3 - must enter at Silver or Gold

Level 4 - Must enter at Gold

Level 5/6 - Must enter at Platinum

Level 7 & up - Must enter at Diamond

Athletes that have never competed must enter XCEL at Bronze or Silver

Entry Deadlines for State meets are coming up!
